1. Application Form

- One form to be completed by EACH applicant.
- Please ensure that the first name you write on the form is the one you wish to have on your badge.
- Couples, please complete one form per person and indicate your partner's name.

2. Accommodation and Accessibility

- a. When planning our Summer School, we have taken a keen interest in providing high quality accessible facilities.
 - All bedrooms have en-suite facilities, and are provided with towels, complementary toiletries, and tea/coffee facilities, along with Wifi and TV with a range of channels.
 - All delegates must be able to participate in the event independently and take full responsibility for themselves.
 - For those who do not specifically book a ground floor room, the ability to manage stairs in the accommodation block is essential.
- b. Those with limited mobility, or who use a wheelchair please book an accessible room in your application. The number of these rooms is limited, and priority will be given to wheelchair users. For specific mobility issues we encourage you to contact the venue direct (01347 825038).
 - The accommodation block is a short walk on the flat from the main building.
 - A stair lift provides access from the 3 steps from the reception area to the level access to dining, conference facilities, bar and social areas.
 - Motorised scooter users can access the main building via a notified entrance and can be parked at a designated spot.

3. Booking a Course

- Please indicate your first and second choice of course on the Application Form.
- You will remain a member of this course for the full 3 days of our Summer School.
- In the event that your first course is cancelled, due to insufficient numbers or unforeseen circumstances, you will be offered an alternative.
- If you choose not to take this option, your deposit will be refunded.
- In the unlikely event of a tutor not being available on Day 1, places will be offered on other courses.

4. The Outline Programme

- Registration will take place from 2:00 pm 4:00pm on the Monday afternoon of 24th August.
- Activities start after registration with a welcome from Pat Collard, Chair of YAHR Summer School Committee, after which you will meet your tutor and be introduced to your chosen topic.
- The bar will be open from 5:00 pm, and a servery dinner from 7:00 pm.
- The event closes after lunch on Thursday 27th August.

5. Costs and Payment Terms

- a. Residential: £495 pp. Deposit £100 pp before 15th February; full payment thereafter
 Non-Residential (includes lunch and evening meals): £256 pp Deposit £75 pp before 31st March; full payment thereafter.
- b. To secure your booking, please send a completed Application Form (and cheque if paying by this method) to **Lesley Tempest, 33 West End Road, Cottingham, HU16 5PL** Bookings are taken on a 'first come first served' basis.
- c. Your booking will be confirmed by email.
- d. Payment of the relevant balance must be received by 30th April.
- e. On or around 30th June we will send out joining details and a programme of events.
- f. **Refunds:** These are made by bank transfer at the discretion of the Committee and regretfully cannot be agreed after 15th May. In considering any refund, we will ask delegates to cover any costs that YAHR incurs on their behalf, which could add up to the full amount.
